Can I apply for funding as a Community Interest Company?

No, we only accept applications from registered charities and limited companies.

I am an individual artist; can I apply for funding?

We do not give funding to individual artists; however, you can apply for funding as part of an organisation.

Do you provide funding for local community/youth projects and events?

It is unlikely that funding would be awarded for a local community/youth project or event.

Can we apply for core funding?

No, grants are awarded to fund project activity. We do, however, understand that to deliver this activity a contribution to core costs may be needed. This should be detailed in the application and clearly stated in the programme budget,

How much should we apply for?

We do not have guidelines on grant size, but we understand it can be challenging to decide how much to request. Our Trustees take a broad range of factors into account when assessing applications. Examples of previously funded projects, including grant sizes, can be found on our [funding](#) page.

Please note that the Trustees sometimes offer a grant amount that differs from the amount applied for.

How will I know if my application was successful?

If your application is successful, we will contact you by email within two weeks of the Trustee meeting date.

My application was not successful. Can I get some feedback?

Due to the volume of applications we receive and the size of our team, we do not provide feedback on applications.

My application was declined. Can I reapply?

If your application was not successful, you can reapply. We do not advise applying for the same project more than twice.

Do you support international projects?

No. We only support projects within the United Kingdom.

What does public benefit mean?

We follow the Charity Commission's definition of public benefit. More information can be found on the GOV.UK website: *Public benefit: rules for charities* (www.gov.uk).

Can I apply for funding toward educational costs for individuals?

No, we do not fund individual educational costs.
